## 2. TIMELINE

### Friday, October 21<sup>st</sup> Schedule:

- 10:00 A.M. - Set-up time opens
- 4:00 P.M. - 6:00 P.M. - Container Pick-up
- 6:00 P.M. - Head Cooks Meeting
- 7:00 P.M. - Margarita Turn In

### Saturday, October 22<sup>nd</sup> Schedule:

- 12:00 P.M. (Noon) - 1 fully jointed chicken halve (to include breast, wing, thigh and drumstick)
- 1:30 P.M. - Pork Spareribs (8 individual pork spareribs)
- 3:00 P.M. - Brisket (8 full slices)
- Judging followed by Awards under the Pavilion
- 6:00 P.M. - 9:00 P.M. - Mark Odom Band under the Pavilion

### Sunday, October 23<sup>rd</sup> Schedule:

- 7:00 A.M. - Clean-up of site begins (no early departures prior to Sunday AM)
- 12:00 P.M. - All sites must be vacated and clean of trash, debris and evidence of use.

## 3. EQUIPMENT

Cool Breeze BBQ Cook-Off Committee is supplying cooking teams with a space of 30'x40'. Cooking teams must supply all necessary equipment and supplies. All teams are required to have a Fire Extinguisher present during times of cooking. Props, trailers, motor homes, RV's, vehicles, tents, generators, coverings and/or any other part of the cooking team's equipment is the sole responsibility of the cooking team and may not extend at any time outside of the designated cooking team space.

Ice and Mesquite Firewood will be on-site available for purchase.

RESTRICTED: Fire holes or open pits are not permitted.

BBQ pits may include gas or electricity to start natural fiber substances to complete cooking.

#### **4. RULES AND REGULATIONS OF COOL BREEZE PAVILION**

The following is a list of rules and regulations to be upheld by the Client, which includes all team members and guests who are involved in the planning and execution of the Cool Breeze Bar-B-Que Cook-Off located at Cool Breeze Pavilion.

- No foul or abusive language or obscene gestures
- No intoxication or other signs of impairment related to alcohol consumption.
- Use of illegal drugs or other illicit substances is not permitted. Violators will be escorted from the premises.
- Physical violence of any kind will not be permitted.
- No obscene or indecent clothing
- Cool Breeze Pavilion, LLC is a 'tobacco free' environment. Smoking is not permitted in or near the Pavilion.
- Cool Breeze Watering Hole will be selling beverages and light snacks throughout the event. Coolers may **NOT** be brought under the Pavilion for functions held there throughout the cook-off. During the awards and Saturday concert, please purchase drinks from Cool Breeze Watering Hole.
- Loud cook site noise and music must end by 10:30 P.M.

#### **5. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

Client acknowledges responsibility for the proper and lawful consumption of alcoholic beverages at Cool Breeze Pavilion, LLC during the duration of the event described in this contract. Client shall abide by all applicable laws. Alcoholic Beverages brought to your event are the sole responsibility of the Client. Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be distributed to minors. Each team must monitor its area as it pertains to these rules. No glass bottles allowed, and no outside alcohol may be brought to the Pavilion.

#### **6. SMOKE FREE FACILITY**

Cool Breeze Pavilion, LLC is a smoke free facility. Smoking is not permitted on the grounds. If smoking materials are discarded under the pavilion, on the turf, in the planters, sidewalks, roadways or any other area of the grounds, an extra cleanup charge will be imposed. Any guests violating the smoking restrictions will be asked to vacate the premises.

#### **7. CHILDREN**

All children under the age of 16 must be supervised by an adult at all times. Adults nor children should NOT wander the grounds, as there is cattle, heavy equipment and potential

hazards located on property. Please do not let children climb on the landscape rocks, trees or plants.

## **8. CLEANUP**

It is the responsibility of the contestants to see that their cook-off space is clean, and all trash bagged up and put into dumpsters prior to leaving. Please provide your own trash can to use at your site. **NO equipment may leave your space any earlier than 7:00am, Sunday, October 23, 2022.** This includes, but is not limited to, tents, pits, RV's, etc. All equipment used by the team is to be removed by 12:00 pm on Sunday, October 23, 2022. Any property left on the premises after 2:00 pm Sunday, October 23, 2022, will become the sole ownership of the Cool Breeze BBQ Cook-off committee

## **9. RESPONSIBILITY**

Cool Breeze Pavilion, LLC does not accept any responsibility for damage to or loss of any articles or property left at Cool Breeze Pavilion prior to, during or after the event. The Client(s) agrees to be responsible for any damage done to Cool Breeze Pavilion, LLC and properties used by the Client(s), his guests, invitees, employees or other agents under the Client(s) control. Further, Cool Breeze Pavilion, LLC shall not be liable for any loss, damage or injury of any kind or character to any person or property caused by or arising from an act or omission of the Client(s), or any of his guests, invitees, employees or other agents from any accident or casualty occasioned by the failure of the Client(s) to maintain the premises in a safe condition or arising from any other cause. The Client(s), as a material part of the consideration of this agreement, hereby waives on its behalf all claims and demands against Cool Breeze Pavilion, LLC for any such loss, damage, or injury of claims and demands against Cool Breeze Pavilion, LLC for any such loss, damage, or injury of the Client(s), and hereby agrees to indemnify and hold Cool Breeze Pavilion, LLC free and harmless from all liability of any such loss, damage or injury to persons, and from all costs and expenses arising there from, including but not limited to attorney fees.

Customer agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Cool Breeze Pavilion, LLC, its officers, staff and agents working on its behalf, from any and all claims, actions, suites, costs, damages, and liabilities resulting from the breach of this Agreement, negligence actions, willful misconduct or omissions of Client, and Client's guests, invitees, agents and sub-contractors.

## **11. SEVERABILITY**

If any provisions of this Agreement shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the remaining provisions shall continue to be valid and enforceable. If a court finds that any provision of this Agreement is invalid or unenforceable, but that by limiting such provision it would become valid and enforceable, then such provision shall be deemed to be written, construed, and enforced as so limited
